

## **Mental Health Community Resources**

**Call 9-1-1, Call SFSU DPS, or go to the nearest Emergency Room if you are having an immediate life-threatening emergency.**

- a. Westside Crisis.** 245 11<sup>th</sup> St. (at Kissling). **Call 415-355-0311 (24hrs)** or drop in M-F 8am-6pm, Saturday 9am-4pm. Culturally competent crisis and urgent care services (averaging 1-3 visits), referrals. For ongoing services, must be 18+ & SF resident. Crisis services open to ANY student, regardless to county of residence. 0\$-full bill. English, sometimes Spanish.
- b. OMI Family Center.** 1701 Ocean (at Faxon). **Call 415-452-2200.** For all San Franciscans aged 3-59. Call M-F 8:30-5:00pm for drop in hours, schedule, screening and scheduling an intake interview. Group, family, and individual counseling, case management, medication management, information, and referrals. 0\$-full bill. English only.
- c. San Francisco County Access Line (Community Behavioral health Services—(CBHS)). (888) 246-3333 (toll-free) or 415-255-3737.** M-F 8am-5pm. Call for authorization and access to all mental health services offered by the City of San Francisco.
