**Call 9-1-1, Call SFSU DPS, or go to the nearest Emergency Room  
If you are having an immediate life-threatening emergency.**

- a. **Westside Crisis.** 245 11<sup>th</sup> St. (at Kissling) San Francisco, CA 94103. **Call 415-431-9000 (24hrs)** or drop in M-F 8am-6pm, Saturday 9am-4pm. Patients must be 18+, SF Resident, and without private insurance. 0\$ full bill. English sometimes Spanish.
- b. **OMI Family Center.** 1701 Ocean (at Faxon). **Call 415-452-2200.** For all San Franciscans aged 3-59. Open from M-F 8:30-5:00pm. Drop in hours from 9:45am-10:45am, schedule, screening and scheduling an intake interview. Group, family, and individual counseling, case management, medication management, information, and referrals. 0\$-full bill. English only.
- c. **San Francisco County Access Line (Community Behavioral health Services—(CBHS). (888) 246-3333 (toll-free) or 415-255-3737 (24 hour hotline).** Call for authorization and access to all mental health services offered by the City of San Francisco.

<b>San Francisco</b> 415-255-3737	Services for those who receive Medi-Cal benefits, San Francisco Health Plan members, and to other San Francisco residents with limited resources; Patient has to make intake call; staffed 24/7
<b>San Mateo</b> 1-800-686-0101	Medi-Cal & No insurance only Call for information, an assessment and a referral based on individual needs
<b>Santa Clara</b> 1-800-704-0900	Medi-Cal insurance & no insurance only
<b>Solano</b> 1-800-547-0495	Medi-Cal & no insurance only (sliding scale) for seriously ill & chronically mentally ill only
<b>Sonoma</b> 1-800-870-8786	Medi-Cal insurance only; provide assessment, linkage, and information and referral for mental health services for children, youth, and adults.
