

IMMUNIZATION HOLD??

Here's what you do:

1. Find your Immunization record (it's an important document to have)
 - It's o.k. if the record is from childhood (yellow booklet)
 - It's o.k. if the record is in paper form (printed from your electronic medical record)
 - It's o.k. if you have a photo (readable) of your record.
2. Ask your parent/legal guardian
3. Ask your primary care provider (physician, nurse practitioner)

Can't find your Immunization Record?

1. If you **absolutely** can't find any record and you know that you **were vaccinated** twice in your lifetime with the MMR vaccine:
 - You can do a blood titer to see if you have antibodies to measles, mumps and rubella
 - Do the MMR titers via your primary care provider if you have insurance
 - Do MMR titers at the SHS
 - **CALL** our appointment line at 415-338-1251 and ask to speak with a nurse
 - MMR titers can be ordered by the nurse
 - MMR titers performed at SHS Lab cost approximately \$25 (billed to your student account)
 - Takes 3-5 business days for results
 - If you don't have antibodies to either measles, mumps or rubella you will need to get vaccinated.
2. If you know you were **not vaccinated** with MMR vaccine:
 - You will need to get 2 MMR vaccines (1 now and 1 anytime four weeks from the 1st)
 - You can go to your primary care provider, some Walgreens or CVS pharmacies, county public health department or the SHS.
 - There is a CVS pharmacy located inside Target at Stonestown offering the MMR vaccine at a cost and they accept most insurances.
 - You can schedule an appointment online via myHealth with the SHS Immunization Clinic. Cost is \$113 per MMR vaccine billed to your student account.

YOU MUST SUBMIT PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION (VACCINE OR BLOOD TEST) TO THE REGISTRAR
